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Admission requirements

- Application
- Official transcripts
 - International transcripts must include an official course-by-course evaluation of all academic work from naces.org
- Two letters of recommendation
 - Letters need to come from employers or professional associates and must attest to your activities as a teacher leader and your potential as a school leader
- Essay on leadership
 - In 2-3 pages double spaced, describe an issue or issues you think will impact leadership in Connecticut schools. It is important that you focus on the issues, their impact on leadership and any personal experience you have had in helping to address them in your current or former position(s).
- Resumé

092 certificate program prerequisites

- Master's degree from a regionally accredited institution with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- A minimum of three years of certified teaching experience is required for entrance into this program
