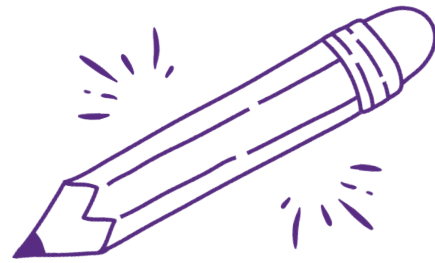

First-year students who apply to UB before our Early Action Deadlines, will receive priority consideration for up to \$25,000 in merit scholarships!

## How to apply to UB

- Complete your free UB application at [bridgeport.edu/apply](https://bridgeport.edu/apply).
- Submit **proof of high school completion or its equivalent** (*this would typically be a transcript provided by your school’s advising office*).

### For first-year applicants:

- Submit a **personal essay**.  
*UB is test optional! You are not required to submit your SAT/ACT scores.*

### For transfer applicants:

- Submit transcripts from all colleges/universities attended.

## Submit your FAFSA

- Confirm UB has your **social security number** by contacting Admissions at 203-576-4552.
  - This is how we connect your FAFSA with your UB application.
- Create an FSA ID at [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov).
  - Write down your username and password so you can access and submit the 2024–2025 FAFSA form when it is available.
- Once available, complete the FAFSA at [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) and use UB’s school code 001416.

UB considers all applicants for available merit scholarships, including:

- Trustee Scholarship: **\$23,000-\$25,000**
- Presidential Scholarship: **\$20,000**
- Provost’s Scholarship: **\$17,000-\$17,500**
- Dean’s Achievement Scholarship: **\$15,000**

## Do you sing or play an instrument?

You could be eligible for a \$1,500/semester scholarship!



\*For first-year students only applying as test optional. Students can submit their SAT/ACT scores in place of a personal essay.

## Congrats, you're in! Now what?



- Receive an admission decision from University of Bridgeport!
- Visit [bridgeport.edu/ubnet](https://bridgeport.edu/ubnet) and use your UB Student ID number located in your acceptance letter to create your UBNET ID and access your student portal.
- When available, view and confirm your financial aid package in your myUB student portal.
- Commit to UB and pay your tuition deposit.
- If you are living on campus:** pay your housing deposit.
- Register for classes with your academic advisor.
- Review your health insurance plan (you may waive this in the summer).
- Pay your bill or make payment arrangements before classes begin.
- Submit your Health forms (not required for online students).
- Complete and submit your Housing Application and Meal Contract forms.
- Register for Orientation!
- Submit all final official transcripts.
- Begin your journey as a Purple Knight!**
