Founded in 1927, University of Bridgeport (UB) is a private, non-sectarian university and is home to a **diverse student and faculty body from over 45 states and almost 80 countries**. UB is accredited by the New England Commission for Higher Education (NECHE).

UB's 56-acre campus is located on scenic Long Island Sound in southwest Connecticut. Within an hour and a half of New York City, students have access to job opportunities, including internships in the world's largest financial center.

Bridgeport is the highest populated city in Connecticut and the local region offers plenty of things to do, including shopping, performing arts, a zoo, museums, and beaches. All UB students may travel at no cost throughout Connecticut using an in-state rail pass, so let the adventures begin!

- Students in Advanced ELI can take academic classes at the same time (Advanced level requires minimum 55 TOEFL or 5.5 IELTS)
- Three levels available

## Scholarships

University of Bridgeport offers scholarships to eligible international students.

### Undergraduate

\$5,000 – \$20,000

Scholarships are renewable as long as students meet the minimum GPA at UB.

### Graduate

\$3,000 – \$4,000

Scholarships are valid for first two semesters (one year) of enrollment.

### Bank statement amounts

Students may deduct awarded scholarships and submit net amount. Students will complete online Affidavit of Financial Support if the bank statement is not in the student's name.
