2023-2024 Alumni First Destination Outcomes

Overview:

This report presents data on the outcomes of University of Bridgeport graduates from the 2023-2024 academic year at eight months post-graduation. The 2023-2024 academic year is defined as July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

To collect outcome data, the Office of Institutional Effectiveness at UB carried out two surveys of graduates, the first in April 2024 and the second during December 2024-January 2025. The Office of Institutional Effectiveness and the Office of Alumni Relations also located additional outcome information through LinkedIn during the fall of 2024 and January 2025. Data from all these sources was combined in January 2025 for the present report.

Presentation of Data:

The term 'outcome' refers broadly to a person's primary activity or status. It denotes whether someone is pursuing continuing education, working, seeking work, serving in the military, or serving in another organization like the Peace Corps.

In reporting the data, a decision was made to emphasize employment over other possible outcomes. This was done for the following reasons:

- 1) The 2024 alumni outcomes data was collected following the standards and protocols of the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE). According to these standards, there can be no 'overlap' in career outcomes – e.g. a student cannot be counted both as working and studying. Unfortunately, prohibiting overlaps in this way obscures the number of people who are studying or serving in addition to employment. As a result, this methodology skews figures related to study and service. Such skewed figures have been excluded below.
- 2) UB's mission statement places particular emphasis on job-readiness. Employment is consequently the most relevant outcome for understanding graduate success at UB specifically.

In this report, the data has been broken down by degree level and academic program. It is reported through the two figures defined below:

Knowledge Rate: the percentage of graduates for which outcome information could be ascertained. This figure is calculated relative to the entire graduating class.

Percent Employed: the percentage of graduates who are employed. Note that this figure is calculated relative to the number of graduates for which outcome information was found – **not the entire graduating class**. This figure does not differentiate between different forms of employment (full-time, part-time, freelance etc.).

Summary

UB is proud to report a **75.92% overall knowledge rate** of graduate outcomes for the 2023-2024 academic year. This rate exceeds the minimum standard of 65% as set by NACE. Knowledge rates for all degree levels and knowledge rates for the majority of individual programs also exceed this standard. As such, the data reported below is largely reliable.

Overall, the reported data indicates that UB sets up all students for career success. For all degree levels, the percent employed exceeds 80%. The same is also true for the majority of individual programs.

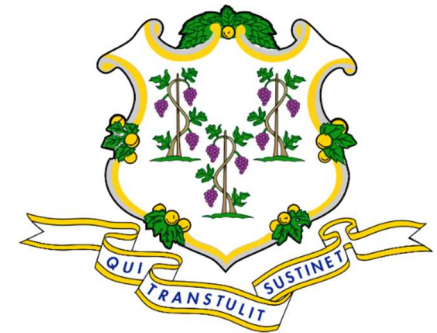
