BS-MPH

After completing your remaining Health Sciences requirements, you will spend a fifth year achieving your MPH.

BS-MS in Human Nutrition

Through our Nutrition concentration track, eligible students can pursue their dual degree in Human Nutrition — beginning graduate-level classes during their senior year before returning for a fifth year to complete their MS studies.

 - Submit transcripts from all colleges/ universities attended (*transfer applicants*).
- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.
- First-year students must submit a personal essay (optional if you choose to submit SAT/ACT scores).
